Actuarial Standards Oversight Council holds its 2nd Annual Public Meeting

OTTAWA (December 5, 2008)—John Solursh, Chairperson of the Actuarial Standards Oversight Council (ASOC), is pleased to invite the media to attend ASOC's 2nd Annual Public Meeting.

The Actuarial Standards Board (ASB) was created by the Canadian Institute of Actuaries as an independent body with the authority and responsibility for establishing actuarial standards of practice. ASOC was set up to serve the public interest by overseeing and providing input to the activities of the ASB. The ASOC is composed of seasoned professionals, academics and business people with experience in the financial sector.
